


Celtic Christianity Tour in the United Kingdom

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Monday, May 30 - Depart USA

Depart on your international overnight flight.

Day 2 - Tuesday, May 31 - Glasgow

Arrive in Glasgow - Join Pre-Tour Group. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon drive to the fishing village of Oban for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - Wednesday, June 1 - Isle of Mull and Iona

Breakfast. Ferry crossing to Isle of Mull and on to Isle of Iona. A small and peaceful isle of the Inner Hebrides, Iona was to become the heart of Celtic Christianity in Scotland when St Columba landed in AD 563 and founded a new monastic community. Trace the story of Celtic Christianity here, which prospered until relentless Viking raids forced many monks to flee the island. The Roman Church would later return in force with a new Benedictine Abbey in the 12th century. Visit the Abbey where numerous Scottish Kings were believed to be buried, including the famous Macbeth. Three original Celtic High Crosses can also be seen. You will also see the nunnery ruins, and the Iona Parish Church with its MacLean Cross outside.

Day 4 - Thursday, June 2 - Iona Day on Own

Enjoy a day on Iona to explore and meditate. Dinner and overnight on the Island.

Day 5 - Friday, June 3 - Iona Day on Own

Enjoy a second day on lona to explore and meditate. Dinner and overnight on the Island.

Day 6 - Saturday, June 4 - Isle of Mull to Oban

Breakfast. Return through the Isle of Mull to Oban for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 - Sunday, June 5 - Trossachs Region

You will journey through the Trossachs region – a majestic region of mountains, lochs, valleys and rolling countryside. Afternoon arrival into Edinburgh. Dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - Monday, June 6 - Edinburgh

Breakfast. Enjoy a morning on own in Edinburgh. After lunch, you will have an afternoon walking tour of the Royal Mile and a visit to Edinburgh Castle, including St Margaret's Chapel – the oldest surviving building in Edinburgh. Dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - Tuesday, June 7 - Island of Lindisfarne

Breakfast. Full day pilgrimage to the Holy Island of Lindisfarne. St Aidan came here from Iona at the request of King Oswald in AD 635 and built his monastery, a place also prominent in the life of St Cuthbert. Explore the priory and Lindisfarne centre, which includes a leather-bound facsimile of the Lindisfarne Gospels in the atmospheric scriptorium. Depart the island and transfer to hotel for dinner and overnight. (Timing on this day is subject to tides which will allow the crossings to/from the island)

Day 10 - Wednesday, June 8 - Durham Castle and Durham

Breakfast. Visit to Durham Cathedral, where monks from Lindisfarne brought St Cuthbert's body; his tomb is still buried here (buried with King Oswald's head), and at the other end of the cathedral are the remains of St Bede enshrined in the Galilee Chapel. Free time in Durham. Dinner and overnight.

Day 11 - Thursday, June 9 - Whitby Abbey and York - to Manchester

Breakfast. Visit to Whitby Abbey, a 7th century Christian monastery that later became a Benedictine Abbey. The abbey was inspiration for Bram Stoker, the author of 'Dracula'. Transfer to York for free time for lunch and walking tour. Dinner and overnight near Manchester airport.

Day 12 - Friday, June 10 - Return Home

Breakfast. Transfer to Manchester airport.

This morning visit Trim Castle. After, depart for Downpatrick. Upon arrival, visit Down Cathedral and St. Patrick's Grave. After, visit the Down County Museum.

On your way north stop at Struell Holy Wells and Saul Church. Continue to Belfast and check in to your hotel.


May 30 - Belfast to Glasgow
