About Our Church

Faith Community Church is a non-denominational Christian congregation in Sheldon, Iowa, with just over 200 active members and an average Sunday attendance of 150–175. We offer two worship services each Sunday:

- 8:30 AM Traditional/Liturgical
- 11:00 AM Contemporary

We are a multigenerational congregation with strong participation among young families, children, and youth. Our community is warm, close-knit, and grounded in Scripture, fellowship, and discipleship.

Sunday School

Classes for ages 3–4 through 8th grade, as well as an adult class. Average total attendance: 50+.

Family Discipleship Night (Launched Fall 2025)

A vibrant Wednesday night ministry including:

- Supper and fellowship
- Children's Ministry (Orange 252 curriculum)
- Impact Youth (middle & high school youth groups)
- Adult Bible Study

Average attendance: 70–80 children and youth and about a dozen adult attendees.
